- The candidates are required to submit only the SOFT COPY (single pdf file) of the application form along with copies of self-attested documents.
- Candidates can apply for both the year (2025 & 2026) in a single application.
- After pre-screening by eminent juries, best 10 entries will be short-listed for presentation during IFO-2027.
- It is mandatory for all short-listed candidates to register for IFO-2027 and oral presentation certificates will be provided to each candidate.
